Called Meeting
Minutes

Call to Order: 5:30pm

Attending: Mayor Missy Holbrook; Council Members Sherri Cheek, Gabbie McFarlin, Mike Barrett and Wesley Dove; City Clerk; Karen Little. See sign in sheet for visitors.

McFarlin made a motion to approve the amended agenda, adding the following 2 items: water/sewer mapping and fire department purchase. Barrett seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to approve March 4 minutes. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Cheek made a motion to approve the cost and move forward with the relocation of the CES playground equipment and metal pavilion given to the city by the Franklin Co School System. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

McFarlin made a motion to accept the quote from Gibson Contracting Services LLC to replace the bridge decking at the city park. Dove seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to approve a request by the fire department to purchase new extrication equipment with SPLOST funds at the approximate cost of \$23,600.00. Dove seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Dove made a motion to approve the proposal from GMRC for mapping of water and sewer system to be paid with SPLOST funds. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to approve the purchase of a 3 bay swing set (6 swings) with shade, for the splashpad area of the park at the approximate cost of \$25,000.00 in SPLOST funds. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

The first reading of the ordinance granting variance with condition to Lula Capital LLC was given by the City Admin Consultant, Gary Fesperman.

Council discussed the upcoming planning and zoning training, tentatively set for April 9th from 1:00pm – 5:00pm. Discussion also included the need to have an additional member on the P & Z Board.

The April 1, 2025 meeting is canceled.

No work session is scheduled for April.

Dove made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:46pm. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.
