Cheek made a motion to approve the amended agenda, removing City Park – Parking Lot Regulations; and adding the following two items: 1. Community Clean Up 2. Code Enforcement. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Dove made a motion to approve the February minutes. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.

McFarlin made a motion to approve a sign variance request made by St. Clairs Sign for Speedway. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Cheek made a motion to approve a task order with EMI for Oconee Well to conduct 72-hour pump testing at the city park well. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Council discussed the upcoming community work day, scheduled for April 22 at 10:00am in the city park. This event will be held alongside a group from Georgia Power, who will carry out park improvements funded by a \$10,000 grant awarded to the city by Georgia Power. The community is welcome and encouraged to participate.

The City Easter Egg Hunt is scheduled for Saturday, March 28 at 10:00am.

Council deliberated favorably on providing two dumpsters for city residents as part of an upcoming spring clean-up initiative, suggesting April 24 – May 8. Further information will be communicated soon.

The Council talked about the need for part-time code enforcement and decided to move forward with this effort.

Dove made a motion to accept the bid from Gary Roberts regarding the city fountain demolition. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.
