Dove made a motion to approve the March minutes. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

McFarlin made a motion to approve an alcohol license for 7-Eleven, Inc. DBA Speedway #42749. Cheek seconded the motion. Dove abstained. Motion passed.

Dove made a motion to extend the water moratorium through August 4, 2026. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Council discussed the city park parking lot and requested the city attorney to prepare an ordinance designating the city park parking lot for park patrons only.
