Dove made a motion to approve the agenda. Barrett seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Cheek made a motion to approve the May minutes. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to approve the first read of the zoning and annexation ordinance regarding parcel 035 016A, applicant: Georgia Stone Products LLC. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

McFarlin made a motion to approve the first read of the zoning ordinance regarding parcels 035 018 and 035 018B and waive the second read. Applicant: Georgia Stone Products LLC, requesting rezone of both parcels from C-I Commercial to I-Industrial. Barrett seconded and motion passed unanimously.

McFarlin made a motion to table the agenda item of requested variance on parcel 036 033 011, applicant: Anthony and Kalyn Fuhrman. Cheek seconded the motion. McFarlin, Cheek and Dove voted in favor. Barrett opposed. Motion passed.

Cheek made a motion to approve the second read of the FY 26-27 budget resolution and adopt the FY 26-27 budget. Dove seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Dove made a motion to approve an ordinance adopting the recodified City of Carnesville Municipal Code of Ordinances and to waive second read. Barrett seconded and motion passed unanimously.

McFarlin made a motion to approve the ordinance to provide for restrictions on parking in public lots within designated areas within the corporate limits of the city of Carnesville. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously. Cheek made a motion to waive second read regarding this ordinance. Barrett seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Dove made a motion to temporarily close the splashpad until a resolution of the water quality from the city park well can be addressed. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to table the agenda item of city park parking improvements. Dove seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Dove made a motion to authorize the mayor to sign all necessary documents regarding the preparation of a project plan and application for the Assistance to Firefighter Grant Program, to provide funding for upgrading the fire department radios. Barrett seconded and motion passed unanimously.

No work session is scheduled for June.

Barrett made a motion to adjourn at 6:44pm. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.
