Cheek made a motion to approve the agenda. Dove seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Dove made a motion to approve the June minutes. Barrett seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to approve the second read and adopt the zoning and annexation ordinance regarding parcel 035 016A and amend the zoning map accordingly - applicant: Georgia Stone Products LLC. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to approve the variance request from Anthony and Kalyn Fuhrman at 5770 Harrison Bridge Road for a 9.5-foot reduction to the rear setback and a 9-foot reduction to the side setback for installation of a 30-foot by 50-foot accessory building. Dove seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Dove made a motion to approve the repeal of moratorium extension on residential and commercial development requiring water service availability. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to move forward with the meter reading project using SPLOST funds. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to approve the splashpad parking improvements using SPLOST funds. McFarlin seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to amend the agenda, adding the item of splashpad operating hours. Dove seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Barrett made a motion to add Sunday hours of 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. to the current splashpad schedule. Dove seconded and voted in favor of the motion. McFarlin and Cheek opposed. Mayor Holbrook broke the tie by opposing the motion, and the motion failed.

Barrett made a motion to add Sunday hours of 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. to the current splashpad schedule, provided the water source remains in good condition. Dove seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

No work session is scheduled for July.

Barrett made a motion to adjourn at 6:40pm. Cheek seconded and motion passed unanimously.
